## TIMING

- Timing will be electronic and be accurate to 1/100th of a second.
- Class winners will be those competitors with the fastest time for a single run in each class.
  - o In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner.
- Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

## ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded by e-mail to all Competitors in the week prior to the event. This advice will include any available Further Regulations or other additional specific information on the running of Hillclimb events at Bryant Park.

- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified.
- The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR.
- A refund of the Entry Fee may be allowed for entries withdrawn at least one week prior to the Event by notifying the Event Secretary or the Clerk of the Course. Entries withdrawn after this date will not receive a refund.
- The Event will be limited to 100 (One Hundred) starters.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.
- The Event Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.
- Protest must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

## GARAGES
